Third Party Reporting

*Third party reporting is a process where a survivor is able to pass on information about the sexual assault they experienced to the police without having to speak directly to the police or make a formal report. In this process the survivor completes a form with the support of a trained counsellor, and this information is sent off to police without the survivor's identifying information.

If the police would like to speak directly with the survivor, they will reach out to the community organization that filed the Third Party report. The counsellor would then reach out to the survivor. Survivors always have the choice to speak with police or not.
