The City of Winnipeg offers a wide range of important animal services, which are primarily funded by your pet licence fees. We are excited to share how your support is making a difference.

When stray dogs are found, Animal Services steps in to care for them until they're reunited with their owners. But that's not all! Your licensing dollars also enable a range of additional services, such as 24-hour emergency response for situations like house fires and police incidents involving animals, emergency veterinary care when it's most needed, and low-income spay/neuter programs

aimed at controlling pet populations and preventing unnecessary euthanasia.

One of the most rewarding programs is our adoption initiative, which gives unclaimed animals a second chance at a happy life with a new family. It is truly heartwarming!

On behalf of our team of staff, volunteers, and the pets in our care, we want to extend a huge thank you for your pet licensing support. You're making a real difference in the lives of animals across Winnipeg!

SPAY/NEUTER SAVES \$\$\$

Did you know that you can save at least \$80 per year on your pet licence if your pet is spayed or neutered?

Spay/neuter:

- Reduces overpopulation
- Reduces cancer risk
- Reduces aggression
- Reduces roaming

Ways to help animals

1. Adopt or foster a dog

Adopting a dog is one of the best ways to support your local shelter or rescue. If adoption is not possible, consider volunteering with us or your local rescue!

2. Vaccinate your dog or cat

Vaccinations help protect the health of your pet and the community. The rabies vaccine is required by law. Visit your veterinarian for more information.

3. Use a harness

A front latching harness provides more control than a standard collar when taking your dog for a walk. Be sure to remove the harness after use.

4. Socialize your pets

Get your friends out for a group walk or take a stroll in an off-leash park.



READY TO ADOPT?



Dog safety for children

As parents and dog owners, we have a responsibility to care for and nurture our children and dogs in a safe environment.

Ready to make some new furry friends? Follow these simple steps!

- 1. The slow approach:** Walk calmly towards the dog and its owner. No rushing! You're showing respect.
- 2. Ask first:** Always ask the owner if you can pet their dog. It's about consent. If they say no, don't take it personally. Move on.
- 3. The sniff test:** If the answer is yes, hold out your hand in a fist, palm up. Let the dog come to you. They'll sniff to get to know you.
- 4. The sniff is a success:** Once they seem comfortable, you can pet them. Go for the chin or chest, that's where dogs love it.

Why these steps?

Dogs can feel threatened easily. By moving slowly and letting them come to you, you're showing you care about their feelings.

Happy dog = happy encounter!





Dogs are available to be taken out for a day or up to a week.

You can bring your canine companion to:

Dogs will wear an "Adopt Me" vest and a sparkling pet licence on their Doggie Date. Leashes, collars, and food are provided.

A fully refundable deposit, equivalent to the adoption fee, is required for the first Doggie Date and can be paid using a debit or credit card. Once you successfully return a dog, no deposit is required for future Doggie Dates. No appointment is necessary.
