1.0 TYPE

1.1 Shall be a portable, 3-wheeled, airless line striper suitable for spraying paint on streets, curbs and parking lots within the City of Winnipeg. The unit shall be furnished complete and ready for use with all features and auxiliary equipment as described herein.

3.1 All items in these specifications must be answered indicating compliance or non-compliance. **Bidders shall state "yes" for compliance or state deviation**, or give reply where requested to do so. 4.1 Machine shall be equipped with a single gun, suitable for spraying straight or curved lines using water or oil based traffic line paints. _____

4.2 Configuration – 3-wheeled cart with heavy-duty steel frame. _____

4.4 Tires – pneumatic type with front swivel wheel. _____

4.5 Power – gasoline driven 5.5 HP engine with automatic clutch. _____

4.8 Maximum Tip – 1 gun @ 0.023 inch, 1 x 8" line. 2 gun @ 0.015 inch, 2 x 4" lines. _____

4.9 Spray-arm – multi-adjustable with quick release gun holder. _____

4.9.1 All gun adjustments shall be made without the use of tools. _____

4.10 Parking brake – required, foot operated. _____

4.11 Paint holder – for use with standard 5-gallon containers, adjustable to any common size paint container.

4.12 Striping tips – one (1) installed per machine plus four (4) additional tips per machine.
