Note: Alternative 1 – Award as a Whole; Alternative 2 – Award by Item

PART B – BIDDING PROCEDURES

Revise B2.1 to read:

B2.1 The Submission Deadline is 4:00 p.m. Winnipeg time, **December 21, 2005.**

Revise B13.1(c) to read:

(c) **Bid Price**

Revise B13.4 to read:

B13.4 Further to B13.1(c), the **Bid Price** shall be the sum of the quantities multiplied by the unit prices for each item shown on Form B: Prices.

Delete B13.4.1

Replace B13.5 with the following:

B13.5 This Contract may be awarded as a whole (Alternative 1) or separately by item (Alternative 2) as identified on Form B: Prices.

B13.5.1 Notwithstanding B8.1, the Bidder may, but is not required to, bid on both alternatives, or on any one or more items in Alternative 2.

B13.5.2 The City shall not be obligated to award any item to the responsible Bidder submitting the lowest evaluated responsive Bid for that item and shall have the right to choose the alternative which is in its best interests. If the Bidder has not bid on both alternatives or on all items in Alternative 2, he shall have no claim against the City if his partial Bid is rejected in favour of an award of the Contract on the basis of an alternative or item upon which he has not bid.

PART D – SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

Revise: D2.1

The Work to be done under the Contract shall consist of supply and delivery of floor sweeping compound, 'Dry All" and "Can Dry", for the period of February 1, 2006 to January 31, 2008.

PART E – SPECIFICATIONS

Add E2.2(b) as follows:

- (b) "Can-Dry" (all purpose), manufactured by Absorbent Products Ltd., Kamloops BC, as follows:
 - (i) Meets the requirements of Canadian General Standards Board Specification 25.14 July 1996. Further to paragraph 8.1 of said Standard shall be Type 1 (absorbent material for oils, liquid fuel, water and water-liquid fuel mixtures);
 - (ii) Shall be packaged in approximately 36 lb. bags;
 - (iii) Provides a non-slip surface during and after use of product; and
 - (iv) After absorption, the residue shall be suitable to be picked up by push brooms.

Add E3.1.2 as follows:

- E3.1.2 No minimum quantities of Goods (bags) per order due to some City locations use the product infrequently and/or are limited to storage space.
