PART E - SPECIFICATIONS

GENERAL

E1. GENERAL

E1.1 These Specifications shall apply to the Work.

E2. SERVICES

E2.1 The Contractor shall provide food and beverage vending services in accordance with the requirements hereinafter specified.

E2.2 The Contractor shall:

- (a) provide, maintain, stock and operate vending machines at the various locations listed in D2.1, to service food and beverages such as soft drinks, bottled water, hot beverages, milk, ice cream, candy, chocolate bars and chips; and shall:
 - (i) be operated year-round throughout the term of the Contractor, except as authorized by the Contract Administrator;
 - (ii) be placed only at locations within the pools(s)/arena(s)/Park specifically authorized by the Contract Administrator;
 - (iii) sell food and beverages from the vending machines at prices not greater than the prevailing vending machine prices in the City of Winnipeg.
 - (iv) be responsible for the collection and handling of monies from the vending machines;
 - (v) provide a good standard of service and value to the general public patronizing the Site(s);
- (b) ensure that all its employees working in these facilities:
 - (i) are dressed in a clean, neat and respectable manner;
 - (ii) have proper identification in the form of:
 - A) a uniform bearing the name of the company (only);
 - B) a photo identification badge, must be worn at all times while on the premises;
 - (iii) behave in a courteous and polite manner to City personnel and other persons in the facility;
 - (iv) are careful with all property that is in or a part of the facility;
 - (v) refrain from using profanity.

E2.3 The Contract Administrator shall have the right, at any time during the term of the Contract:

- (a) specify the types and brand or brands of food, beverages or merchandise to be sold at the Site(s);
- (b) require the Contractor to replace a vending machine if it displays advertising or a logo that is not consistent with the brand specified by the Contract Administrator;
- (c) be the sole judge as to the adequacy and value of service and may order such changes or alterations to the his/her sole discretion as he/she may determine to be advisable.

E3. SCHEDULE OF WORK

E3.1 The exact dates of commencement and termination of Work shall coincide with the following:

- (a) Operating schedule of each pool;

- (b) Operating schedule and off-season special events schedule of each arena for each season;
- (c) Operating schedule of the Assiniboine Park locations.
