Revise: B2.1 to read: The Submission Deadline is 12:00 noon Winnipeg time, February 28, 2008.

Add: B9.4 Notwithstanding C12.2.3(c), prices on Form B:Prices shall not include the Manitoba

Retail Sales Tax (MRST, also known as PST), which shall be extra where applicable.

PART D - SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

Revise: D13.1 to read: The Contract Administrator has developed a Project Master Schedule for the Work.

This schedule will be available in the offices of the Contract Administrator and will be

updated as required as the Work progresses.

Revise: D13.2 to read: The work is dependent on the progress of the work of Contracts 742-2005 and 95-

2007. The Contractor shall coordinate the Work, through the Contract Administrator, with the work of the mechanical and electrical installation contractor (742-2005) and the

contractor for Bid Opportunity 95-2007 Construction of Offices and Plant Interior

Finishes.

Revise: D13.3 to read: While it is intended that the Contractor shall be allowed, in general, to carry on the

Contract in accordance with such general plans as may appear to him to be most desirable, as permitted within the progress of Contracts 742-2005 and 95-2007, the Contract Administrator, at his discretion, may direct the order in which, and points at

which, parts of the Work shall be undertaken.

Revise: D13.4 to read: This control shall be exercised in the interests of the City so that the Work or other

Contractors who may be working on the site may be coordinated with the Work on this

Contract.

Revise: D13.5 to read: The Contract Administrator shall be notified immediately when the Work under the

Contract Work Schedule will adversely affect the work of other Contractors and the critical path of the Project Master Schedule as the Work under the Contractor's Contract Work Schedule is an integral part of the Project Master Schedule.

Revise: D13.6 to read: The Contractor shall be familiar with all other Contract Work Schedules as contracted

by the City with other Contractors and the critical path of the Project Master Schedule.
