PART B - BIDDING PROCEDURES

Revise: B10.3

B10.3 The Bidder and/or any proposed Subcontractor (for the portion of the Work proposed to be subcontracted to them) shall:

- (a) have successfully carried out work similar in nature, scope and value to the Work; and
- (b) be fully capable of performing the Work required to be in strict accordance with the terms and provisions of the Contract: and
- (c) have a written workplace safety and health program, if required, pursuant to The Workplace Safety and Health Act (Manitoba);
- (d) have licensed personnel conducting the annual inspection and testing of a Sprinkler System qualified in accordance with Fire Prevention By-law No. 150/2004 and Sprinkler System Installer must have a Sprinkler System Installer License issued by the Province of Manitoba.
- (e) have licensed personnel conducting the annual inspection and testing of Fire Alarm Systems qualified in accordance with the Fire Prevention By-law No. 150/2004 and as set out in the Manitoba Fire Code Article 6.3.1.5.
- (f) have licensed personnel conducting the annual inspection and testing of Emergency Lighting qualified in accordance with the Fire Prevention By-law No. 150/2004 as set out in the Manitoba Fire Code Article 6.3.1.5.
- (g) have personnel providing the inspection and testing of special extinguishing systems (i.e. FM-200 Manual Fire Suppression System) be qualified in accordance with the Fire Prevention By-law No. 150/2004 which states:
 - (i) Service Personnel Qualifications: Set out in the Manitoba Fire Code Article 6.3.1.5. <u>and employed</u> by a company approved as an authorized service agency by any manufacturer of a gas-based fire suppression system
 - (ii) A license (as per by-law 150/2004) would be required.
