Any parts or accessories not specifically mentioned, but which are required to complete and place the Combination Roller in successful operation shall be furnished as though specifically mentioned in these specifications. The complete Combination Roller and attachments, and all parts thereof, shall conform in strength and quality of material and workmanship, to the best standards and engineering practice of the industry.

Note: The first payment of the contract on the equipment will not be issued until successful completion of training has been conducted to the satisfaction of the Contract Administrator.
