PART E – SPECIFICATIONS

Revise: E18.7.1(d) to read: There are a total of **228** existing post tensioning tendons (**38** over each pier) that will remain in the concrete deck following completion of structural removal operations.

Revise: E20.7.3(a) to read: The aluminum art balusters and gateway **panels** shall be fabricated as shown on the Drawings.

Add: E20.7.3(b) The wording of the aluminum art balusters shall be laser cut. Wording is provided for pricing purposes only, as included below in Table E20.1. The final wording to the aluminum art balusters shall be finalized after award of Contract. The locations of the laser cut aluminum art balusters shall be installed as directed by the Contract Administrator.

- Add: E42.3.2(a) Concrete for the structural sidewalk and curb shall be Type 2 as specified on Table E12.1. Refer to E12, "Structural Concrete" for requirements of Type 2 concrete.
- Add: E42.3.2(b) Reinforcing steel shall be stainless steel, meeting or exceeding the minimum requirements of ASTM A955M, 300 Series, minimum Grade 420. Refer to E11, "Reinforcing Steel" for requirements of stainless steel reinforcing.
- Add: E42.7.2 Structural Sidewalk
- Add: E42.7.2(a) Construction of structural sidewalk shall not be measured. This Work shall be paid for at the Contract Lump Sum Price for "Structural Sidewalk", performed in accordance with this Specification and accepted by the Contract Administrator, which price shall be paid in full for supplying all materials and for performing all operations herein described and all other items incidental to the Work.
