Located at Approximately N 49° 52' 54" - W 97° 08' 54", RL 1 of the Parish of St. John to RL 41 and 42, Parish of St. Boniface, City of Winnipeg, Assiniboine River, in the Province of Manitoba

**IMPORTANT NOTICE:** 

This document approves the work in terms of its effect on marine navigation under the Navigable Waters Protection Act. The work must be built, placed, maintained, operated, used and removed in accordance with the approved plan(s), the Navigable Waters Protection Act, its regulations and the terms and conditions in the Approval. It is the applicant's responsibility to obtain any other forms of approval, including building permits, under any applicable laws.

WHEREAS the above-named applicant has made application to the Minister of Transport, Infrastructure and Communities under the Navigable Waters Protection Act for approval of the abovedescribed work at the above-referenced site in accordance with the attached plan(s);

WHEREAS it is considered advisable to approve the said work at the said site and plan(s) thereof for a period of 5 years pursuant to the Schedule referred to in subsection 3(1) of the Navigable Waters Works Regulations.

THEREFORE, the Minister of Transport, Infrastructure and Communities, pursuant to subsections 5(1) and (3) of the Navigable Waters Protection Act, hereby approves the said work at the said site and plan(s) thereof for the period of time aforesaid, providing:

- 1. The construction of the work is started by April 1, 2011 and finished by December 31,
- 2. Navigation lights to be moved vertically to display immediately below work platform for the duration of the project.
- 3. Notification of the temporary reduction of vertical clearance and the project schedule shall be sent to the Owners of the River Rouge tour boat and the Paddlewheel tour boats, with copy to this office, one month prior to commencement of the project.



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## 4. Warning signs shall:

- Be placed and maintained during all periods of open water and in stream activity.
- Be legible at a minimum distance of 50 meters.
- Be placed 200 meters upstream and downstream of the site on each bank of the waterway until completion of the project.
- Display black letters on a yellow background.
