PART B – BIDDING PROCEDURES

- Revise: B2.1 to read: **The Submission Deadline is 4:00 p.m. Winnipeg time, May 16, 2014.**
- Revise: B11.7 to read: The Bidder and/or any proposed Subcontractor (for the portion of the Work proposed to be subcontracted to them) shall **within five (5) Business Days of a request by the Contract Administrator:**
 - (a) provide a list of suitable equipment (make, model, year) in accordance with E4, and delivery schedule in order to accomplish the commencement dates D2.1 and service types;
 - (b) provide number of vehicles proposed to be used to perform 100% of the Work in accordance with E4.14.
 - (c) the software, hardware, web-based application and implementation plan with regards to the E4.21 GPS-AVL requirements **as indicated in E4.23.**

PART D – SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

- Revise: D19.2(b) to read: Indexes “A”, “B”, and “C” will be those prepared by Statistics Canada. **Index “D19.1.2(b)”** will be prepared by Henry Hub. As some of the indexes are not available from Statistics Canada until sometime after the adjustment date, the amount of adjustment will be retroactive to the adjustment date.

PART E – SPECIFICATIONS

- Revise: E4.14 to read: **The Contractor is responsible for determining the appropriate number and type of vehicles and equipment to perform 100% of the Work requirements. The Contractor shall provide to the Contract Administrator the number of vehicles required to perform the work in the Contract as per B11.7(b) and maintain this number throughout the Contract.**
- Add: E11.7 **If there are zero (0) missed collections, damage by or concerns about collection on any scheduled collection day, an incentive bonus in the amount of seventy five dollars (\$75.00) per day will be paid.**

Add: E11.8

In order to allow for the Contractor to become familiar with the work, E11.5 and E11.7 will not apply for the first month.

Add: E11.9

Any and all claims for damage assigned to the Contractor by the City will be classified as property damage, and must be handled within the same timeframe as in E11.4. If, after one collection cycle, the property damage is still unresolved, the City will settle the claim and deduct any material and payment deductions from the monthly progress estimate.
