Question and Answer

Q1 What is the funding available for this project?

A1 The Winnipeg Police Board has determined not to prescribe or disclose a set budget amount for this project.

The Board may, as exigencies require, adjust the allocation of its budget, but it cannot permit its total expenditures to exceed the funding available within its budget.
