

LAYOUT PLAN - PATHWAY IMPROVEMENTS SCALE 1:200




EXISTING LIGHT POLE

EXISTING DECIDUOUS TREE



PLANTING NOTES

- LOCATION OF ALL PLANT MATERIAL TO BE MARKED OUT ON SITE AND APPROVED BY CONTRACT ADMINISTRATOR PRIOR TO PLANTING.
- 2. PERENNIAL SPACING AS SHOWN ON PLANTING PLAN
- 3. ALL PLANTING EXCAVATIONS ARE TO BE REVIEWED AND APPROVED BY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT PRIOR TO PLACEMENT OF DRAINAGE COURSE, FILTER FABRIC AND/OR SOIL
- 4. PLANTER BED IN PLAZA TO HAVE PLANTS SET BACK 450mm FROM EDGE OF WALL TO ALLOW FOR ANNUAL PLANTING (BY OTHERS)
- 5. PLANTING BEDS (SHRUB BED OR MULCH BED) WITH TREES MUST HAVE MINIMUM 900mm DEPTH PLANTING SOIL FOR THE ENTIRE AREA OF THE BED.
- 6. ALL PLANT MATERIAL TO BE BEST QUALITY. PLANT MATERIAL TO BE REVIEWED ON SITE BY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT ON SITE PRIOR TO PLANTING. PLANTS NOT ACCEPTABLE ARE TO BE REPLACED AND NEW PLANTS APPROVED PRIOR TO PLANTING. REPLACEMENTS ARE AT THE CONTRACTOR'S OWN COST.
- 7. PLANT MATERIAL MUST BE NO.1 GRADE NURSERY STOCK, SUPPLIED AND INSTALLED IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE LATEST EDITION OF THE CANADIAN NURSERY LANDSCAPE ASSOCIATION 'CANADIAN STANDARDS FOR NURSERY STOCK'.
