After purging, Tank One will be delivered in condition for re-use to the City of Winnipeg Fleet Management Agency at 185 Tecumseh;
- Revise: D2.2(b) to read: Removal of Above Ground Storage Tank Two. Tank Two (Serial # D-607038) is a split tank with a capacity of 20,000L and a current volume of 6476L of purple diesel and 269L of unleaded gasoline. After purging, Tank Two will be delivered in condition fir for re-use to the City of Winnipeg, Water & Waste Department at a location to be described at the Brady Landfill and 4R depot;
- Revise: D2.2(c) to read: Removal and disposal of all associated piping, dispensary equipment and concrete fuel pump island.
- Delete: D2.2(d)

- Add: E4.1.3 (a) With the exception of the VeederRoot system and Computrol unit which are to be returned to Winnipeg Fleet Management Agency at 185 Tecumseh.
