Notice to Bidders of the City of Winnipeg's Intent to Issue a Future Bid Solicitation for the North End Sewage Treatment Plant Upgrade - Information Only

NORTH END SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT UPGRADE [NEWPCC]

The North End Sewage Treatment Plant (NEWPCC) is the City of Winnipeg's largest sewage treatment plant at 302 MLD and provides approximately 70% of the City's sewage treatment, serving a population of 404,000. The City is in the process of upgrading plant technology to meet both requirements of a Manitoba Regulatory License, and to replace end-of-life equipment. Design will accommodate 2037 influent flows and loads with provisions for future expansion to 2067 population forecasts. The project also includes biosolids processing and wet weather flow treatment upgrades.

Update No. 4: The NEWPCC Upgrade preliminary design work is continuing and achieving project milestones. RFQ, RFP and Technical Requirements for the project continue to advance. The issuance of the RFQ is being delayed to allow for input from the preliminary design activities and the RFP development. The RFQ posting is anticipated in Q4 2017. This notice will be updated as the RFQ posting date approaches.

Future site tours will be offered in conjunction with the open period of the Request for Qualifications. Additional site tour information will be provided in a future update. Access to the facility is not available prior to this.
