

DEMOLITION GENERAL NOTES:

- 1. PERFORM WORK IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL APPLICABLE CODES AND REGULATIONS.
- 2. EQUIPMENT LOCATIONS AND PIPE ROUTING INDICATED ON THE DRAWINGS IS APPROXIMATE ONLY. CONFIRM IN THE FIELD. REROUTE PIPING AS REQUIRED TO ELIMINATE FIELD INTERFERENCES, WITH BUILDING STRUCTURES, ELECTRICAL, ETC.. CONFIRM CHANGES WITH CONTRACT ADMINISTRATOR. CO-ORDINATE WORK WITH ALL SUBTRADES. WHERE DIMENSIONS ARE INDICATED FOR PIPING EQUIPMENT SIZES, ETC. THESE ARE FOR BIDDING PURPOSES ONLY. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE TO VERIFY ALL DIMENSIONS IN THE FIELD PRIOR TO ORDERING EQUIPMENT AND COMMENCING INSTALLATION WITHOUT EXTRA CHARGES TO THE PROJECT. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE TO ENSURE ALL EQUIPMENT, DUCTWORK AND PIPING FITS IN THE SPACE AVAILABLE AND TO MAINTAIN THE GENERAL DESIGN INTENT FOR THE SYSTEMS.
- 3. ALL REMOVED EQUIPMENT SHALL BE DISPOSED OFF SITE. CONFIRM WORK WITH OWNER IF ANY MATERIAL SHALL BE TURNED OVER TO
- 4. SEAL ALL OPENINGS REMAINING FROM REMOVED EQUIPMENT, DUCTWORK, PIPING AND, AND CONTROLS. FINISH AND PAINT TO MATCH EXISTING.
- 5. IN THE EVENT THERE ARE DISCREPANCIES ON THE DRAWINGS AND/OR SPECIFICATIONS, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL REQUEST CLARIFICATION FROM THE CONTRACT ADMINISTRATOR PRIOR TO CLOSE OF TENDERS AND PRIOR TO PROCEEDING WITH CONSTRUCTION. CLARIFICATION WILL BE PROVIDED WITH THE INTENT OF ELIMINATING EXTRA COST TO THE CONTRACT.

KEYNOTES:

- 1 REMOVE EXISTING ELECTRIC DUCT HEATERS (EDH-#) AND ASSOCIATED CONTROLS. EXISTING DUCTWORK TO REMAIN.
- 2 REMOVE EXISTING ROOF TOP AIR HANDLING UNIT (RTU-2) AND ASSOCIATED CONTROLS. DISCONNECT THE NATURAL GAS CONNECTION. EXISTING DUCTWORK AND CURB TO REMAIN.
- REMOVE EXISTING ROOF TOP CONDENSOR UNIT (CU-2) ASSOCIATED WITH RTU-2. DISCONNECT AND REMOVE INERCONNECTING REFRIGERANT PIPING. REFRIGERANT TO BE DISPOSED OF PER APPLICABLE REGULATIONS.

THE CONTRACTOR IS TO REVIEW AND COORDINATE ALL ARCHITECTURAL, MECHANICAL, ELECTRICAL AND STRUCTURAL DRAWINGS FOR ADDITIONAL OPENINGS THROUGH FLOORS WALLS, AND CEILINGS FOR DUCT, PIPE & ELECTRICAL RISERS AND ALL OPENINGS NOT

ALL OPENINGS THROUGH THE FIRE SEPARATIONS AS A RESULT OF THE WORK OF THIS CONTRACT ARE TO BE FIRE STOPPED AND SEALED WITH ULC APPROVED FIRE STOPPING TO MAINTAIN THE INTEGRITY OF THE FIRE SEPARATION, AND PROVIDE AND SMOKE-TIGHT




