QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q1: Should the costs for the testing of materials during construction as per B9.5 be included in the Time and Expenses for Resident Contract Administration fee under B 9.2(b)?

A1: Yes, per Appendix A, section 7.5(i) resident contract administration services include carrying out the testing of materials utilized by the construction contractor.

Q2: Are any public engagement activities to be performed (e.g. open house, public information session, targeted correspondence to key stakeholders)?

A2: There will not be a specific or comprehensive public-engagement scope, so open-houses or public information sessions are not anticipated. As per section D6.4 there are a number stakeholders at City of Winnipeg (eg. Parks and Open Spaces, Naturalist Services, Active Transportation Co-ordinator) and external stakeholders or stakeholder groups (eg. The Forks or Manitoba Paddling Association) with whom the consultant should contact with respect to their interests in the project and the use of the river access. As per section D7.5 successful consultant will be responsible for preparing and distributing notices to residents located along haul routes and adjacent to the Park.
