## **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

- Q1: B9.4 indicates "shall exclude the costs of any materials testing, soils and hazardous materials investigation as part of the Work." Can you please confirm that any laboratory testing for soil, groundwater, and surface water would be excluded from the fixed fee?
  - A1: Soil testing, groundwater monitoring, or laboratory testing will be approved utilizing funds from the Additional Work Allowance and shall be excluded from the fixed fee. The Sampling/Infrastructure Assessment Plan is expected to be complete before this phase can begin, as this deliverable will form the proposal for approval to use the additional work allowance.
- Q2: Related to Q1 and B9.4, if costs are excluded can you provide the laboratory that the City would retain so that we could confirm CALA or SCC certification for proposed testing.
  - A2: Contracted laboratories shall be approved by the City Project Manager. The City laboratory is a CALA certified lab and may be used for this project. The City also has an existing contract with ALS laboratories which is also CALA certified.
