### PART B – BIDDING PROCEDURES

- Revise: B10.1 to read: Proposals should include:
- (a) details demonstrating the history and experience of the Proponent and Subconsultants in providing design, management of the project, and contract administration services on **three (3)** projects of similar complexity, scope, and value for the Proponent and two (2) projects of similar complexity, scope, and value for each Subconsultant
    - (i) If more than three (3) projects are submitted for the Proponent, only the first three (3) referenced projects will be evaluated. If more than two (2) projects are submitted for each Subconsultant, only the first two (2) referenced projects will be evaluated.

### PART D – SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

- Revise: D11.4(a)(i)(ii) to read: Notwithstanding C1.1(b), the Proponents fees associated with D11.4(a)(i), and the fees to pay for **drill rig access**, geotechnical drilling, geotechnical sampling, geotechnical instrumentation, geotechnical materials testing, geotechnical monitoring, and geotechnical analysis and reporting **associated with borehole logs** as authorized by the Consulting Contract Administrator, will be reimbursed as an Allowable Disbursement under the Geotechnical and Regulatory Permits Allowance outlined in D18.
- The Consultant shall ensure that the selected third-party services are provided at competitive market rates.
  - Costs shall be substantiated by the provision of suitable documentation.
- Add: D12.2(a)(iv): The combined sewer outfall will remain in place and will not be affected by the works.
- Add: D12.5(e): Arrange and attend tree assessment site visits with the City's Urban Forestry Branch at all three (3) Branch 1 Aqueduct Underdrain Outfall locations to determine which trees (if any) need to remain on site during construction, and during the Geotechnical Investigation at Rue Plinguet.
- (i) The Water and Waste Department will pay the City's Urban Forestry Branch directly for their work.
- Add: D14.8: Review and update two (2) Water and Waste standard construction notices, and deliver to residents and businesses in the vicinity of the three (3) Branch 1 Aqueduct Underdrain

Outfall locations, and in the vicinity of the Underdrain rehabilitation along Rue Notre Dame.

Add: D14.8.1: The construction notices shall allow three (3) weeks for the City's review before delivery to residents and businesses.

Revise: D18.1 to read: The Geotechnical and Regulatory Permits Allowance in the amount of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) is to be used for the Proponents fees associated with D11.4(a)(i), and for the fees to pay for **drill rig access**, geotechnical drilling, geotechnical sampling, geotechnical instrumentation, geotechnical materials testing, geotechnical monitoring, and geotechnical analysis and reporting **associated with borehole logs**. This allowance also includes all of the Proponents fees and regulatory permit fees related to D12.6(a) to D12.6(h).
