Revise: D31.1 to read: If the Contractor fails to achieve Critical Stages, Substantial Performance, or Total

Performance in accordance with the Contract by the days fixed herein for same, the Contractor shall pay the City the following amounts per Calendar Day for each and every Calendar Day following the days fixed herein for same during which such failure

continues:

(a) Each Critical Stage as defined in D28.1(a) through D28.1(h) – Ten Thousand dollars

(\$10,000);

(b) Substantial Performance – Ten Thousand dollars (\$10,000);

(c) Total Performance - Two Thousand dollars (\$2,000).

Revise: D31.2 to read: The amount specified for liquidated damages in D31.1 is based on a genuine pre-

estimate of the City's damages in the event that the Contractor does not achieve Critical Stages, Substantial Performance, or Total Performance by the days fixed herein for same. In no event shall the total value of liquidated damages assessed per Calendar Day

be in excess of \$10,000.00.

PART E - SPECIFICATIONS

Revise: E16.7.5 (i) to read: After the hydro-demolition

After the hydro-demolition is completed, the remaining concrete surface shall be inspected through methods of sounding by the Contract Administrator to ensure that all deteriorated concrete has been removed. Should deteriorated concrete be found, the Contractor shall remove the areas of deteriorated concrete, identified by the Contract Administrator, by additional passes of the hydro-demolition equipment or other equipment approved by the Contract Administrator. Measurement and Payment for removal of these areas will be in accordance with E18.
