Please be advised road construction on Callum Crescent from Donwood Drive to Donwood Drive will soon begin.

**Construction Start Window: Week of May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2025**  
**Duration: Approximately 5-6 weeks, weather permitting**

We will:

- Adjust manholes and drainage inlets
- Fix damaged pavement and curb
- Repave the roadway with asphalt
- Restore the boulevard

During construction:

- Callum Crescent will maintain one lane open for traffic
- There will be no on-street parking
- Garbage and recycling will continue as scheduled
  - Please place your bins as usual and Contractor will relocate bins for collection if needed, please mark your address on your bins so they can be returned to the correct address

Please contact me if you have:

- Accessibility needs
- Access and delivery requirements
- Planned special events
- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six meters (20 feet) of the curb
- Questions or concerns about the project

*NOTE: New topsoil and sod may be placed on the boulevard as part of this Project. While the Contractor will maintain the turf for about a month or so, we do not maintain residential boulevards on an ongoing basis.*
