### **3<sup>rd</sup> CONSTRUCTION NOTICE**

**TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF RUDOLPH BAY**

**RE: 2024 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM -  
RUDOLPH BAY FROM SNOWDON AVENUE TO SNOWDON AVENUE**

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We are planning to complete the remainder of the road construction on Rudolph Bay this summer.

**Construction restart window:      Between July 2 and July 14, 2025**  
**Duration:                                      Approximately 2 weeks, weather permitting**

We will:

- Repave the road with an asphalt overlay

During construction:

- Rudolph Bay will be local-access only
  - The street will be closed to through traffic
  - The street will be inaccessible during asphalt paving. The contractor will provide 24 hours notice by mail so you can move your vehicle before this closure begins.
  - There will be no on-street parking
  - Emergency access will be maintained
- Garbage pickup and recycling days will not change
  - Put out your carts as usual
  - The contractor will relocate carts as needed
  - Put your house number on your bins so our crews can return them to the proper locations if they are moved
