## **1<sup>st</sup> CONSTRUCTION NOTICE**

**TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF ROANOKE STREET**

**RE: 2024 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM -  
ROANOKE STREET FROM MELROSE AVENUE EAST TO PANDORA AVENUE EAST**

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We are planning road construction on Roanoke Street this year.

**Construction start window: Week of May 12, 2025**  
**Duration: Approximately 4 weeks, weather permitting**

We will:

- Repair the pavement, sidewalk and curbs as required
- Pave the road with an asphalt overlay
- Restore the boulevard and approaches

During construction:

- Roanoke Street will be local access only
  - The street will be closed to through traffic
  - We will maintain access to all intersections
  - There will be no on-street parking
  - Emergency access will be maintained
- Garbage pickup and recycling days will not change
  - Put out your carts as usual
  - The contractor will relocate carts as needed
  - Put your house numbers on your bins so our crews can return them to the proper locations if they are moved
