TO: RESIDENTS EAST OF UNIVERSITY CRESCENT

RE: LOCAL ACCESS EAST OF UNIVERSITY CRESCENT DURING WINNIPEG BLUE BOMBER GAMES

We are currently doing construction on both University Crescent and the Pembina Highway Overpass at Abinojii Mikanah. Both projects require multiple lane closures. We recognize this significantly impacts traffic.

We have developed a modified traffic management plan to improve access and traffic flow on Winnipeg Blue Bomber game days. The following will be in effect on each game day starting June 12 (and until further notice):

Pre-game (90 minutes before kick-off until one hour after kick-off)

- Local access will be available using Wedgewood Drive via University Cr (between Pembina Hwy and Wedgewood Dr).
- University Cr from Thatcher Drive to Dysart Road will be one-way southbound only.
 - Two-way traffic will remain open between Pembina Hwy and Thatcher Dr.
 - There will be no southbound left turn from University Cr onto Thatcher Dr.
- Eastbound and westbound traffic on Thatcher Dr approaching University Cr will be limited to right turns only onto University Cr.
 - To avoid confusion, eastbound Thatcher Dr at Pembina Hwy will be marked "Road Closed, No Exit".

Post-game (one hour after kick-off until 90 minutes after the game concludes)

- Local access will be available using Wedgewood Dr via University Cr (between Pembina Hwy and Wedgewood Dr)
- University Cr from Dysart Rd to Thatcher Dr will be one-way northbound only.
 - Two-way traffic will remain open between Pembina Hwy and Thatcher Dr.
 - Southbound University Cr at Thatcher Dr will be limited to right turns only onto westbound Thatcher Dr.
- There will be no access from Thatcher Dr onto University Cr or across University Cr.

Please note: Timing estimates for pre-game and post-game traffic control are approximate and subject to change.

We will monitor game-day traffic throughout the season and update the plan as required. The full schedule for the Winnipeg Blue Bombers home games can be found online at www.bluebombers.com
