





SEINE RIVER CROSSING STUDY

A new bridge between the Windsor Park Golf Course and the St. Boniface Golf Club would help reduce cycling and walking distances.


A bridge at Kavanagh St. could connect Dufresne neighbourhood residents to the trail network on the west side of the Seine River.

Connecting Southdale to Marlene Park would allow pedestrians and cyclists to avoid crossing Bishop Grandin Blvd. to cross the Seine River.

TOP 2 PRIORITIES FOR A NEW SEINE RIVER CROSSING



1. Connections to pedestrian and cycling corridors
2. Distance between existing crossings
