What Are Neighbourhood Greenways?

Neighbourhood Greenways...

- Are bike routes introduced on neighourhood streets with low vehicle speeds and volumes.
- Include a range of treatments to slow down traffic and reduce traffic volumes to improve safety for walking, biking and driving.
- Make all modes of transportation comfortable



- for people of all ages and abilities.
- Improve safety and liveability.
- Provide landscaping, wayfinding and streetscaping opportunities.

Below is a toolbox of possible treatments. Opportunities are available to tailor treatments throughout the corridor.

Intensity of Treatments

Treatments can be scaled to affect and increase the level of traffic calming on the street by impacting traffic flow and vehicle, pedestrian, and bicycle speed.







