Attention: Haulers of Commercial Garbage

On October 28, 2009, City Council considered our report recommending that the Solid Waste By-law be amended to allow us to set up legal agreements with haulers of high volumes of commercial garbage and other municipalities.

Council referred the report back to the Standing Policy Committee on Infrastructure Renewal and Public Works with instructions that our department consult with industry.

Under the agreement (called Put or Pay), haulers would:

- receive a reduced tipping fee,
- haul a predetermined additional weight of garbage to the Brady Road Landfill, and
- be required to pay the total contract price even if they don't haul the volume of garbage outlined in the agreement.

The purpose of this initiative is to remain competitive with other landfills and sustain or build the revenue generated at the Brady Road Landfill.

We invite you or a representative of your company to an information session on the Put or Pay Agreement. There will be an opportunity for you to comment on the recommendation. We will include your feedback in our report to City Council for consideration in March 2010.
