The impact of COVID-19 on Brady

 Continuing practices put in place in March to keep customers and staff safe



Landscaping and Long-term Site Planning

- Continue to monitor plantings done last year and earlier this year
- Everything planted is doing well



Odour, Noise and Nuisance Management

- Received 13 odour complaints since last meeting
 - from 12 individuals
 - 1 determined not to have originated from Brady
 - Most complaints related to digging up old garbage for LFG expansion
 - No complaints since September 25
- Bird management on site going well
- Litter control continues, including use of new screens



Site Improvements, Seasonal & Project Activity

- Upgrading of service road along Perimeter is underway
 - tree removals have been required
 - working with Hydro and Province to rebuild
- 2020 curbside yard waste collection ended November 14



Reducing the Impact on the Environment

- Landfill gas capture expansion complete
 - \$3.2 million (incl. \$1.3 million from Federal Government)
 - added 15 wells, 4,700 metres of piping
 - will help with odour and leachate control
 - advised of work on website, 311, media and area
 Councillors



Research Partnerships & Resource Development

- Landfill gas beneficial use study
 - study is complete
 - results expected to be presented to Council in Q1 of 2021

New business

- Residential Food Waste Collection Pilot Project
 - includes approximately 4,000 homes
 - collection began October
 - food waste is being composted at Brady
 - upcoming webinars on November 24 & 25 targeted towards pilot participants but all are welcome
