RE: APRIL 2005 MONITORING REPORT FOR THE WEST END WATER POLLUTION CONTROL CENTRE LICENCE NO. 2669 E

Attached please find the April 2005 Monitoring Report for Licence No. 2669 E issued for the City of Winnipeg West End Water Pollution Control Centre (WEWPCC). Please note the following:

- 1. There are missing raw flow data for four days and missing samples for two days. This is related to some work being done on the control systems at the plant. Estimated flows have been included in the total flow as per Note (6) on the report.
- 2. On April 4 a lab error resulted in no results for total phosphorus and TKN.
- 3. On April 5 a sampling error resulted in no results for ammonia and ortho-phosphorus.
- 4. On April 13 a lab error resulted in no results for total phosphorus and TKN.
- 5. On April 20 there was a change in the effluent discharge from the lagoon as per Note (5) on the report.
