RE: DECEMBER 2005 MONITORING REPORTS FOR THE WEST END WATER POLLUTION CONTROL CENTRE LICENCE NO. 2669 E R AND THE NORTH END WATER POLLUTION CONTROL CENTRE LICENCE NO. 2684 R

Attached please find the December 2005 Monitoring Reports for Licence No. 2669 E R issued for the City of Winnipeg West End Water Pollution Control Centre (WEWPCC) and Licence No. 2684 R issued for the City of Winnipeg North End Water Pollution Control Centre (NEWPCC).

Please note the following respecting the report for Licence #2669 E R:

- 1. On December 6, there was a quality control failure on cBOD5; the results were therefore not valid.
- 2. On December 13, the automatic sampler failed resulting in no sample.
- 3. On December 17, operating staff did not report to the plant and a sample could not be collected.
- 4. On December 18, the sample bottles overflowed resulting in no sample.
- 5. On December 24, the pH and temperature results were not recorded.
- 6. On December 28 and 29, a digestion error for total phosphorus resulted in no results.

Please note the following respecting the report for Licence #2684 R:

- 1. On December 6, there was a quality control failure on BOD5 and cBOD5; the results were therefore not valid.
- 2. On December 4, 20, 25 and 28, a digestion error for total phosphorus resulted in no results.
- 3. On December 20, a digestion error for total nitrogen resulted in no result.

The nutrient digestion errors are the result of a faulty digestion block. We are in the process of ordering a new block which should resolve this recurring problem.
