Notice of Upcoming Work in Seven Oaks Neighbourhood

Starting the week of January 28, 2013, we will begin installing new sewer pipes to help protect homes in this area from basement flooding. The new sewers will also help protect the water quality of our rivers and Lake Winnipeg by reducing the frequency of combined sewer overflows.

This work will take about six months and will include:

- installing sewers between Jones Street and Scotia Street, and between Smithfield Avenue and Jefferson Avenue
- replacing the water main along Jefferson Avenue between Jones Street and Scotia Street

During construction:

- 1. Your water and sewer service will not be interrupted.
- 2. Your recycling and garbage collection will not be affected.
- 3. There will be some parking and traffic restrictions starting January 28, 2013:
 - Jefferson Avenue will be closed between Jones Street and Scotia Street.
 - Traffic will be limited to local access only in the rest of the construction area.

Borland Construction Inc. will be the contractor for this project.

To keep your children safe, please keep them away from the construction site at all times.

We understand this work may cause you some inconvenience and we appreciate your patience.
