Notice of Upcoming Construction in Seven Oaks Neighbourhood

Starting July 26, 2013, we will begin installing new sewer pipes to help protect homes in this area from basement flooding. The new sewers will also help protect the water quality of our rivers and Lake Winnipeg by reducing the frequency of combined sewer overflows.

Construction area

This work will:

- take about four months.
- include installing new sewers between Jones Street and Scotia Street, and between Jefferson Avenue and Belmont Avenue.

During construction

- 1. Your water and sewer service will not be interrupted.
- 2. Your recycling and garbage collection will not be affected.
- 3. There will be some parking and traffic restrictions starting as early as July 26, 2013:
 - Scotia Street will be closed at the junction with St. Anthony Avenue,
 - Traffic will be limited to local access only in the rest of the construction area.

Borland Construction Inc. will be the contractor for this project.

To keep your children safe, please keep them away from the construction site at all times.

We understand this work may cause you some inconvenience and we appreciate your patience.
